1. General measures

Situation	Measures
Check-In	The check-in will take place on Friday 22.10.21 from 3 to 7 pm., participants are advised to arrive on time. The check-in is located at entrance B of Technopark Winterthur.

1.1. Mask obligation

Situation	Measures
General	Within Technopark Winterthur, masks are obligatory. The mask obligation must be respected during the opening hours of the Technopark in all rooms to which third parties also have access. (Until Friday 5.30 pm)

1.2. COVID-19 certificate

Measures
This is a COVID-19 certified event.



All participants must be able to present a certificate. The COVID-19 certificate will be checked on site together with an identity card. Digital certificates from the Covid Certification App (CH) and the CovPass App (EU) as well as printed certificates are accepted.

Persons who cannot present a valid certificate will be turned away.

The organizer is responsible for effective control.

2. Hygiene

Measures

The sanitary facilities at Technopark Winterthur, are signposted, open and accessible.

3. Particularly vulnerable persons

Measures

Participants who belong to the risk group as defined by the FOPH will be informed of the risks in advance and asked to refrain from participation if necessary.

4. COVID-19 diseased

Measures

Persons exhibiting symptoms are prohibited from entering the Technopark Winterthur.
